- To create opportunities to inform the community about resources that already exist





- All surveys were conducted in late summer/early fall of 2014
- Survey participants self-identified as African American and North Minneapolis residents
- Survey results were compiled and data was evaluated in early 2015
- Final report was created in early summer 2015







MONTHLY INCOME















HOW STABLE IS YOUR CURRENT HOUSING SITUATION?




HOMEOWNERSHIP RATE COMPARISON














Of the 887 people responding to whether or not they had ever been homeless, almost ½ of the respondents had been homeless (roughly 4 out of 8 above)

Of those ¹/₂ (423 respondents) over 75% had been homeless for a period of 3-6 years






DO YOU KNOW HOW TO FIND YOUR CREDIT SCORE



HAVE YOU EVER BEEN DENIED A RENTAL BECAUSE OF YOUR CREDIT SCORE?




